2024 EKO UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

One very critical component of a quality educational experience is access to highly trained and qualified Special Education teachers. To further this end, the EKO is partnering with the College of Education at California State University, Dominguez Hills to offer two scholarships for \$1,500.00 each to two students enrolled in the student teaching track in either Mild Moderate Support Needs or Extensive Support Needs.

Selection will be based on the student's financial need and dedication to providing a quality education to students with special needs.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for an EKO Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Enrolled in good standing in CSUDH College of Education Preliminary Special Education Specialist Program Student Teaching Pathway with the intent of obtaining either a Mild Moderate Support Needs or Extensive Support Needs Credential.
- 2. Scholarships are non-renewable or transferable.
- 3. Relatives and family members of the EKO Board of Directors are not eligible.

TO APPLY:

Applicants must submit a completed application including a personal statement and a current resume. Applicants must be willing to participate in an interview via zoom as a part of the selection process.

DEADLINE: Applications must be received no later than <u>November 1, 2024</u>, Successful applicants will be notified by December 1, 2024.
